

## **Video Specifications for EuroSys'21 (main conference only)**

- Authors must record and submit **two videos**:
  1. A shorter video (up to 12 minutes). The shorter video will be played live for you by the EuroSys organizers during the event in the time slot designated to your paper. A live question-and-answer (Q&A) session will follow.

*We are requesting both the “raw video file” and “YouTube link” for the shorter video.*

2. A longer video (up to 20 minutes). The longer video will be posted on a designated Slack channel to allow participants to view the material and start discussing the paper. (Slack channel information will be provided shortly after registration).

*We are requesting only the “YouTube link” for the longer video.*

**Important note:** If YouTube is inaccessible in your country, you can upload the raw video files for both (short and long) videos.

- **Submission deadline:** Monday, 19 April 2021, AOE
- **File format:** H.264 MP4
- **Resolution:** 1080p (suggested), 720p (minimum)
- **Aspect ratio:** 16:9
- **Maximum file size:** 500MB
- **Clear audio:** Headphones and headsets are permitted.
- **File name:** Before submitting your videos, please rename them using the following naming convention:
  1. Eurosys21\_short\_[paper-submission-ID].mp4
  2. EuroSys21\_long\_[paper-submission-ID].mp4 (*only required if YouTube is inaccessible in your country*)
- **YouTube video names:** Please see the video submission site for the naming convention (link sent separately).
- **Video format:** Picture-in-picture, featuring fullscreen slides and a speaker inset, similar to the format below:
